- At Caring House, we offer each resident peace, comfort and support. And space and time for resolution and reconciliation. Last wishes may be fulfilled, stories may be written and memories shared and created.
- Family members and friends freed from care and supervision duties are able to spend their energy supporting and connecting with their loved one and each other.
